#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **Terms:** Terms of the sale are cash or good check, with photo identification. All donkeys must be paid for immediately at sale end. No animals may be removed prior to close of the sale, and all donkeys must be removed from the premises by 8 PM, unless other arrangements have been made with the sponsors.
- **Bidding:** All donkeys sell to the highest bidder. Any disputes or challenges will be settled by the auctioneer, and the auctioneer's decision will be final. The auctioneer may reject any or all bids. Bids are per lot. Jennets with foals on the side sell as one lot. Driving teams sell as one lot.
- **Risk:** The owner assumes all risk for the donkey up to the point of sale. The buyer assumes all risk at the moment the auctioneer declares the animal is sold. The management is not responsible for loss or damages to personal property.
- Announcements: All announcements on sale day from the auction block will take precedence over the material printed in this catalog. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the catalog. However, we assume no liability for errors or omissions.
- **Contract:** The management, auctioneers, and employees act as agents for the seller, but assume no liability for either the buyer or the seller. Any representations made by the sales management are made on behalf of the seller.
- The above terms and conditions shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller of each animal sold. All guarantees are between buyer and seller.
- **Health:** The EIA/Coggins test will be less than 6 months old. Current health papers for transportation with state stamp, should be good for 7 days past sale date. Proof of pregnancy from a veterinarian is required for bred jennets, otherwise sold as exposed. Buyers are responsible to obtain the paperwork they need from the veterinarian after payment immediately following the sale.
- **Transport:** We may be able to help you get your donkey(s) home. Please let us know if you may need this assistance.
- **General:** Please note that donkey heights in the catalog have been provided by the seller. These may be adult or immature heights and are included only as helpful data. We encourage you to measure donkeys you are interested in purchasing, if the data provided seems inaccurate via visual inspection. All donkeys will be measured in public view at a designated area after arrival at the fairgrounds. Time to be announced.

We are pleased to announce that we will be offering an outstanding sorrel gelding, The Elms Roy Rogers, to be sold to support the NMDA Gelding Incentive. This is your chance to help promote geldings, the 'Ambassadors to the Breed'.

#### NMDA Program Information

In order to further the National miniature Donkey Association's (NMDA) goal to protect and promote the Miniature Donkey Breed, the Board of Directors recently approved the creation of the NMDA Miniature Donkey Gelding Incentive Program. The Board strongly believes that by promoting geldings as true 'Ambassadors to the Breed', they will enhance the future of Miniature Donkeys by demonstrating their endearing gentle qualities and, at the same time, have a positive effect on an overabundance of jacks in the population.

The program is primarily intended for those who need assistance with veterinary expenses. For eligible NMDA member participants, the program provides a \$50 rebate subject to specific requirements including proof of castration and gelding registration. This unique program, believed to be the first of its kind for large animal breeds, was inspired by dog/cat spay/neuter programs.

#### Tax Deductibility


